MISSION

Pierce County Project Access exists to improve the health of individuals, families and communities by ensuring pathways to health services for Pierce County residents in need.

GOALS AND STRATEGIES

- **Providing access** by serving all eligible, uninsured residents of Pierce County.
- **Reducing barriers** by maintaining the largest possible network of volunteer providers.
- **Providing health literacy education** by providing careful care coordination for each individual patient

PROGRAMS

Donated Care

A network of 700 physicians, ARNPs and other providers who volunteer care to uninsured patients enrolled in the program.

Premium Assistance

Pays the monthly premiums of any silver-level policy on the WA Healthplanfinder website for those who qualify.

ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- \$36 : \$1** For every dollar spent on program administration, \$36 in care is donated.
- \$3.4 : \$1** For every dollar spent on program administration, \$3.4 in emergency care is averted.
- < 1%** No-show rate for a population with an expected no-show rate of 50%
- \$39 M** To date, our active network of 700 volunteer providers have donated more than \$39 million in care to our patients.
- 55%** On average, PCPA helps reduce non-emergent emergency room visits by 55%.
- \$.94** For every dollar donated, \$.94 goes directly to patient services.

SCOPE OF SERVICES *(Donated Care only)*

ELIGIBILITY

Donated Care

- Pierce County resident for at least 3 months
- Income below 300% Federal Poverty Level
- Must be uninsured
- No citizenship requirement

Premium Assistance

- Pierce County resident for at least 3 months
- Income below 400% Federal Poverty Level
- Must file taxes each year
- U.S. Citizen or Legal Permanent Resident
- Cannot be offered other affordable health insurance

Growth in the number of partners who financially support the organization allows us to continue being our county's #1 resource for access to healthcare without barriers.
